The Rideboard is a free service of Get There, spearheaded by the Oregon Department of Transportation to help Oregonians share the ride and plan trips. Learn more at GetThereOregon.org.





Using the Rideboard to share the ride is easy:

- Visit **GetThereOregon.org** and click the "**Get There Too**l" button to **sign up or login.**
- 2 Click "Dashboard."
- Find "Upcoming Rideboard Trips" on the right and click "View All."
- Click "Post a Ride" and fill in the details.
 - Under "Trip Interest," select "Passenger
 Only" if you are looking for a ride or "Driver
 Only" if you want to offer a ride.
 - If you're flexible, select "Driver or Passenger."
- If you find a trip match, send the user a message to connect.
 - Your message will be emailed to them and they can reply directly to your email address.



Check if there are posted rides: See if someone is already looking for a ride or offering one.
