#### **Commute Costs Have Risen**

Commute costs—fuel, vehicle maintenance, insurance, parking, and more—add up. US workers today spend about **19% of their annual income** on commuting.



#### Commute Distances Are Longer

More workers now **commute from farther away**, adding to commute costs and time spent on the road.

#### **Consultation & Planning**

#### **Employee Support Services**

- Transit Trip Planning—equip employees to plan commute trips on transit using Oregon's <u>Get There Connect</u> tool and your local transit provider's website or mobile app.
- Discounted Passes—transit providers offer group pass programs for employes to extend discounted passes to employees.
- Emergency Ride Home—many transit providers offer programs to help commuters using transit to get home in case of an emergency.
- ▶ Benefits & Rewards—offer free or discounted transit passes and take advantage of local employee rewards programs.

## Set Up A Pre-Tax Commuter Benefit for Tax Savings

Reduce your payroll taxes, while enabling employees to save money on their taxes by setting up a pre-tax commuter fringe benefit. Employees can set aside up to \$300 per month to cover transit expenses for pre-tax savings. Employers can save about by about 7.5% in payroll taxes on the amount employees set aside.
